WoodLot Donation Ground Rules

(Rev.) January 2024

- <u>Wood donations are not accepted without prior</u> <u>discussion/approval and placement coordination.</u> (Points of Contact (POC) provided below.)
- <u>All wood donations must be hard wood</u> and well suited for fire chimney burning (no Pine, Redwood, Cedar, Douglas, or any ever-green.)
- "Wood rounds" are preferable in 18-20" lengths. They <u>must</u> be small enough (in diameter) for a 2-man team to lift into a normal sized pickup truck.
- Placement location for "wood donations" is important. The center of the WoodLot, close to any existing wood splitters, is the priority placement for wood rounds.
- "Split wood donations" can be placed close to the rows of existing split stacked wood starting with the furthest left row as you approach the Wood Lot.

(The POC can provide direction for placement when communicating prior approval/coordination.)
